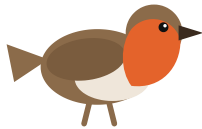

orange-red face and chest



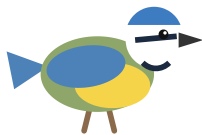
Blackbird

black with a yellow beak (females are brown)



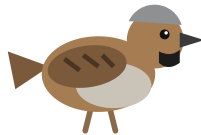
Magpie

blue cap, yellow tummy



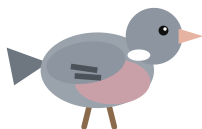
House sparrow

brown and grey, loves to chatter



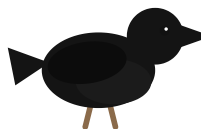
Starling

red face, yellow on its wings

Bird spotting tips

- Stand still and be quiet
- Look up in trees, on roofs and fences
- Listen: can you hear birds singing?
- Notice colour, size and tail shape
- Never disturb nests
- Never touch sick or dead birds
